



Landscape Model Builders Needed

Frederick Law Olmsted National Historic Site (NPS) is seeking individuals with model-building experience to construct topographic model bases for use in a hands-on education program for third graders.

The program, *Good Neighbors: Landscape Design & Community Building*, introduces the profession of public park design to third grade students in Boston and Brookline public schools. The program is structured as a series of hands-on activities, including the opportunity to design and assemble a scaled landscape model using ready-made cork bases and attachable hardscape and planting components.

The selected applicant(s) will:

- Produce two each of five different topographic bases;
- Build bases according to construction specifications;
- Use materials and adhesives provided by the NPS;
- Create a professional quality, precisely built final product;
- Deliver the completed topographic bases no later than August 6, 2010.

A compensation of \$2,100 will be paid upon delivery and approval of the finished bases.
